

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Dear Parishioners,

I hope that you had a nice 4th of July weekend and that the summer weather will continue to stay with us during these remaining summer months!

One day last week, someone asked me where we stand on the Capital Campaign. I mentioned to that individual that things are progressing; unfortunately, not as quickly as I would like them to.

- We are ready to embark on a rather large project; a new roof for the school. You will notice supplies on the school property. The Melanson Roof Company has been awarded this project and began this past week. The project will take almost two months to complete. They will remove the old roofing material and replace it with new insulation and install a new rubber roof on the sections that are in need.
- In addition, a project started last fall on the OLMM roof will be completed. The bell tower and part of the roof on south side of the church near the side entrance will be repaired, hopefully by summer's end. We are awaiting the contractor to schedule us on his calendar.
- We have WV Engineering preparing design drawings and specifications for the heating system and ventilation system at Sacred Heart School in addition to a preliminary design for a fire protection system (i.e. sprinkler system).
- We are also in the process of having the exterior walls of both churches waterproofed from the ground to the roofline.
- And finally, the refurbished and/or replaced handrails around all of the campus have been completed by Cassidy Brothers.

This just gives you a brief summary of the work that is being done at this time. Thank you for your generosity! I encourage you to continue to be supportive of the campaign by meeting your campaign obligation. I recognize the sacrifices you make and appreciate your generosity. Without you, these projects would never be accomplished. I will keep you posted in the near future on the work that is being accomplished.
